<p data-bbox="213 1601 528 1666"><b>What will the weather be like?</b></p>	<ul data-bbox="632 1451 1374 1816" style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Temperature: While temperatures can still be quite warm, June is part of the "cool" season for northern Australia, with daytime temperatures often in the low-to-mid 30s°C and cooler nights.</li> <li>● Conditions: June is in the middle of the Dry Season, meaning there is very little rainfall, low humidity, and almost constant sunshine.</li> <li>● Dry Season: This is considered the best time to visit the Kimberley as the weather is less sticky/humid than early in the year.</li> </ul>
